



12th APSAVD Congress, Taipei Taiwan, September 20-22, 2019



Over 500 people attended the 12th APSAVD congress hosted by the Taiwan Society of Lipids and Atherosclerosis in September 2019.

The delegates hailed from all over the globe, from the UK, Netherlands Italy Russia Israel and Germany, to the USA, and across Asia (Vietnam, China, Hong Kong, Malaysia, Indonesia Japan the Philippines, Singapore South Korea Mongolia and of course Taiwan). It was held at the CHANG YUNG-FA FOUNDATION International Convention Center.



Abstracts

An overwhelming amount of abstracts were received with 120 in total. Abstracts were fairly evenly spread across:

- Epidemiology of ageing, vascular disease, dyslipidemia or metabolic syndrome.
- Basic science research of atherosclerosis, endothelium, inflammation, microcirculation or thrombosis/hemostasis.
- Cardiometabolic disease: basic/translational science and clinical research
- Familial hypercholesterolemia: basic/translational science and clinical research.
- Imaging in atherosclerosis and cardiovascular disease.
- Lipids and lipoprotein metabolism: basic/translational science and clinical research.
- Microbiota and nutrition: basic/translational science and clinical research
- Novel interventional therapies for atherosclerosis, vascular disease or metabolic disorders.
- Vascular diseases and thrombosis: clinical science.
- Big data and precision medicine.

Of the submissions there was 96 poster presentations and 24 oral presentations.

Awards

APSAVD presented 5 awards of these 4 oral awards were given out and 1 poster award. The oral awards for Clinical Science were given out to Chien-Ting Pan for their presentation on Evaluation of Vascular Dysfunction in Primary Aldosteronism using Wave Reflection and the second award went to Meng-Chen Hsu for their presentation on Development and Validation of a 5-year Cardiovascular Risk Assessment Tool for Asian Elderly over 75 years of Age. The awards for Basic Science went to Shih-Hsin Cheng for their presentation on Endoplasmic Reticulum Protein Thioredoxin Domain Containing 5 Contributes to Endothelial Dysfunction and Atherosclerosis by Destabilizing Endothelial Nitric and the second award went to Xiaowei Wang who presented on Targeted Drug Therapy: Effective and Localised Anticoagulation without Bleeding Risks. Additionally, the poster award was presented to Sukma Azureen Nazli for their poster on Familial Hypercholesterolaemia among patients with Coronary Angiogram-proven Premature Coronary Artery Disease.
